The St. Patrick Endowment Trust Scholarship Application

This scholarship is for one year and is not automatically renewed; an annual renewal request, with substantiating documentation, is required. If for any reason the scholarship recipient is unable to use the scholarship during the ensuing academic year, the student forfeits his/her right to the funds. The scholarship check will be made payable to the under-graduate educational institution the student will attend.

Eligibility requirements include:

- Must be an active and participating parishioner of St. Patrick Parish.
- Must be an active participant in the St. Patrick PSR program or in an area Catholic High School.
- Must plan to attend a four-year university or college, community college, or vocational school in the United States.
- Minimum GPA of 2.5

Applicants must submit a completed application (with appropriate Guidance Counselor endorsement), and two (2) recently written (dated 2025) letters of recommendation – one from a teacher or counselor who can attest to your commitment to academics and school involvement (and, if you've already decided upon it, your prowess for your chosen field of study) and one from a school administrator, work supervisor, or community leader, who is not a relative, who can attest to your character. All must be submitted **no earlier than 1 February 2025 and no later than 15 March 2025**; incomplete and/or late submissions will not be considered.

The St. Patrick Endowment Fund Scholarship committee will review all applications and make the final selection(s). Finalists may be called for an interview. Amounts awarded may vary amongst recipients; individual need, intended course-of-study, etc., may serve as factors that influence the amount received. Decisions will be made and recipient(s) will be notified by 30 April 2025.
